





Important notice

Users who want to connect their LinkedIn profile to their LinkedIn Learning account should note that they will have to go through two sign-on processes:


First, the State of Missouri Sign-In to verify you are a State of Missouri employee.

Second, the sign-in to your personal LinkedIn profile.

Sign-in as your domain\username or as your username@fulldomain, for example username@domain.state.mo.us .

You may click [here](#) if you want to change your password now.

- Follow the prompts until the State of Missouri Sign-In screen is displayed. This will be available for ITSD consolidated departments and MoDOT.
- Enter the domain for your department (ads, bds, cds), a backslash (\), and your network username on the first line (e.g. bds\SmithT).
- Department domains:
ADS – DED, DHE, DIFP, DNR, DOC, DOLIR, DOR, MDA
BDS – DESE, DPS, OA
CDS – DHSS, DMH, DSS
- Enter your network password on the second line. This is the same password you use to log into your computer.
- If your division is a non-consolidated ITSD entity, then enter your work e-mail and follow the prompts.

During the activation process, you have the option to connect your LinkedIn profile to your LinkedIn Learning account.


Only learning data will be shared with the State of Missouri. No other data from your LinkedIn profile will be accessible.
