Open Labs for Microsoft Applications

The Center for Management and Professional Development (Center), Information Technology and Computer Skills Training Section, is offering a new series of learning events called ***Open Labs for Microsoft Applications***.

The goal of our *Open Labs* concept is to provide someone who may have taken a computer training course from the Center the opportunity to return to the Center to further their skill development by working on a specific project they are responsible for back on the job—while in the same rich learning environment the Center provides.

We also know that there are times when even skilled employees who regularly use Microsoft applications can get “stuck” working on a new project, or while attempting to learn something new about a specific Microsoft application on their own.

During the *Open Lab*, an instructor will be available to answer any questions learners have on the software. Learners should bring their own material or database with them to receive the one-on-one assistance they need.
